

Exploring Abstract painting Styles

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Supplies

Acrylic, Gouache, Oil & Watercolor are all welcome in the class.

1st class we will be doing some drawing/doodling and some watercolor/gouache exercises. Bring:

Pencils, pens, charcoal, copy paper or drawing paper, watercolor paper and painting tape (app 1" & 2" wide). Either watercolor or gouache with brushes.

If you do not have experience painting, consider using Gouache or Watercolor for this class. Below are the supplies you can start with.

- Paper, drawing – copy paper can be used
- Paper, painting – Arches Watercolor Pad, Cold Press, 10" x 14", 140 lb Cold Press \$24.57
- OR
- Fabriano Artístico Enhanced Watercolor Block, 140 lb Cold Press, 14" x 20", \$57.63
- Pencils – Staedtler 2B & 6B \$2 each, or mechanical pencil
- Eraser – Staedtler Mars Plastic \$1.50
- Ruler – Westcott Plastic Ruler, clear, 18", 8ths \$6.37
- Palette – Richeson 20 Well Tray, \$7.50
- India Ink – Higgins Waterproof Drawing India Ink, Black, 1 oz \$5.97 &/or
- Higgins Dye Based Drawing Ink, 1 oz \$6.51, Indigo or the color of your choice. These inks can be blended.
- Watercolor set – Winsor & Newton Professional Watercolor Essential Set, \$35.99
- OR
- Gouache Set – Winsor & Newton Designers Gouache Primary Set, \$37.05
- Brushes – Round 10 \$8.54, Flat 12 \$6.39 and additional brushes you like.
- Plus, one or more brushes for ink only.
- Bring plastic container for water.
- Paper towels for clean-up.
- Yellow Frog Tape – app 1" roll & 2" roll, \$8.70 & \$15.20

Total approx. \$150

If you paint with Acrylics or Oils, bring these supplies starting the 2nd class.

Painting on canvas - Gesso and Turpentine are Not provided, so prime your surfaces before class.
