Materials list for beginning Watercolor Class - Marty Meade

Paints

- Winsor Newton Cotman Water Colours 20 x 5mi Tubes (about \$21 on Amazon)
- Neutral Tint Winsor Newton

Watercolor Paper – 140# (9x12 pad, cold or hot press)

Brushes:

- Rounds #1 and #6
- Wash Brush ¾" or 1"

Masking Fluid: Pabéo Drawing Gum

Blue Tape ½" (Painters tape, Hardware store)

Saral Graphite paper: **Black** (comes in rolls, can be reused, and will last for years)

Eraser – Design Kneaded

Paint Palette – white china plate or enameled tray (thrift store)

Water containers: 2 plastic, (about one quart each)

Toilet paper (essential tool for lifting paint)

Hair dryer

Note: this is a suggested list. Ok to use the paints that you already have. Yarka, is a good brand. I have recommended PRANG for years, but they recently changed their product and found the primary colors to be pale and different then the color wheel.
